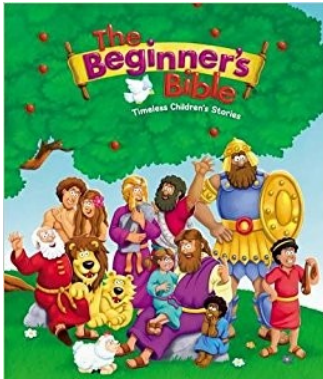

2018 SCRIPTURE READING PLAN: Please read the listed scriptures on this calendar each day. There are Old Testament readings for each Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, New Testament readings for each Thursday and Friday, and a selection from the Psalms each week day. By following this plan each month, we will read through the **entire bible** in 2018 in less than 30 minutes a day! There are no assigned readings on Saturdays—feel free to use this to “catch up” if you get behind during the work week.



FOR FAMILIES WITH KIDS—Two readings have been provided each week from “The Beginner’s Bible”. Read the Old Testament story on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday and the New Testament story on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Yes, you will read the exact same story three days in a row—repetition is a great learning tool for young children. If you have older kids or teens at home, have them read the story aloud for you or their younger siblings. **If you don’t have a Beginner’s Bible at home, we have some in the church office! Let Pastor Dave know you would like one.** CrossView Student Ministries will be teaching the same stories each weekend that you have read during the week. Together, we will get God’s word into the hearts of our students!
